GRADING FOR WINTER SEASON

The fist 2 rounds of the grading phase are complete and the JCC (Junior Competitions Committee) met on Monday night for their first grading meeting. To make all the grading changes these are based not only on results but also the observations and notes made by the Grading Secretary for each age group, but also numerous other assistants that a watching matches over various venues. The beginning of the winter season is always the most difficult to grade, as teams progress into higher age levels. Sometimes trying to find exactly where the team fits in the new age group may take several grading changes for them to fall into the correct grade. **Grading changes will still be made in coming weeks**

Round 3 - 1:1 swaps may be made to see if a team will be better suited higher or lower.

Round 4 - After completion another full grading will be done of all teams.

If at any stage your team in completely in the wrong division (whether too high or low) email the club and your grading request will be submitted on your behalf.

Many grades will have a different number of teams in the fixture compared to the first 2 rounds. With the growth of the competition and the limited court space, FDBA have added many Byes throughout age groups. This had to be done to eliminate bringing in 7pm game times. (No one wants that!)

FOR ALL OUR NEW U8 TEAMS - For the U8 competiion the grading is also a very difficult task, so this will help explain the process a bit more.

This year there are 67 teams playing in the U8 competition. Around 60% of these teams are registered as new teams. And around a third of all teams register in the bottom division, To begin teams are tried to be split with the top 3 divisions being existing teams and therefore the older U8s. And the bottom divisions are made up of younger or girls teams. With the majority of girls teams being in bottom two divisions. So it is very difficult to determine where the majority of the teams should sit. There are always signifigent margins in the results in the first few rounds. Therefore there are signifigent changes throughout the whole 7 divisions. The top 1 or 2 divisions and also the bottom division fall into place fairly quickly. It is the middle divisions where it is hard to separate teams. So there are 3 divisions of 11 teams after round 2 (to included Byes required).
